

### English

As readers and writers, we will be reading Alan's Big Scary Teeth and we will be working on describing using adjectives as well as using the conjunction 'and'. Through our role-play we will be writing a travel journal, where we will visit Africa and write about the animals we see. **Read regularly with your child. Homework will be based around phonics. Encourage correct letter formation when writing.**

### Maths

As mathematicians, we will be looking at place value of numbers up to 50. We need to count in tens and ones. We will also be looking at standard and non-standard units with relation to length, height, mass and volume. **Practice counting in tens and ones and recognising the numbers to 50. What is one more or one less than a given number.**

### Science

As scientists, we will be looking at how the weather changes throughout the seasons. We will look at how shadows and puddles are formed. We will also take part in Science Week activities. **Look at the weather and note how it changes with the seasons. What are plants and trees doing?**

### R.E

As theologians, we will be looking at the story of Easter. We will be performing Easter songs in the church.

### Art and Design

As artists, we will be looking at what it means to be an artist. We will be using textiles and carry out some wool wrapping and weaving

**Practice making abstract textile art using wool and scraps of fabric.**

### Humanities

As historians we will be looking at our local history. We will be looking at the Boxford Village sign and we will discuss the significance of each part. We will also look at the local war memorial too.

**Have a look at the village sign and point out the war memorial in the church yard.**

### P.E

As athletes, we will be taking part in invasion games and practicing the skills needed to attack and defend. We will also be practicing yoga poses through various themes.

**Practice ball skills, including passing, dribbling and bouncing.**

### Music

As musicians, we will be using the Charanga scheme to listen to and appraise different tunes, as well as exploring beat and rhythm.
