

### English

As athletes, we will be learning how to play tag rugby (Tuesday afternoons) and gymnastics (Monday afternoons). Pupils will learn how to evade and tag opponents, pass and receive the ball. Within our gymnastics sessions, we will look at working collaboratively to create sequences of balances and rolls. ***Look into a local rugby team, see how they play together***
