As readers and writers, we will study the story *Fantastic Mr. Fox* where we are going to create a newspaper report on the story.

You can help at home by looking at newspapers and find some of the features.

R.E

As theologians, we will learn the religion *Christianity* and understand what 'reconciliation' means and why it is important. We also learn the story 'The lost boy' and how this is linked to reconciliation and we can use this in our everyday lives.

Humanities

As geographers, we will learn how our local area has changed over time. We look at how and more importantly why Boxford has changed for better. We will explore the local village on a walk to the different parts seeing how the village has expanded over time.

You can help at home by looking at other local areas see if they have changed over time and why.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will understand numbers up to 1,000, comparing numbers, column addition, column subtraction with 2-digit and 3 3-digit numbers.

You can help at home by looking learning the method or column addition and subtraction with exchanging.

Art and Design

As artists, we will understand why food is grown seasonally and how this has changed over time. To know how to peel and cut a vegetable and fruit. Also, to cook a tart using the skills we have learnt.

You can help at home by cutting and peeling the food with adult supervision.

As athletes, we will learn how to play the game dodgeball by working in small teams. Also, learn different moves in Dance and create a performance.

You can help at home by catching different sized balls along with using different throwing actions (underarm, overarm etc)

Science

As scientists, we will learn how to keep healthy by understanding the different food groups and how they help our body. Also, to learn about skeletons and that some animals do not have skeletons.

You can help at home by looking at different animals to see if they have a Skelton or not along with looking at food to see how much is in it.
