

## English

## R.E

As Theologians, our topic will be Islam. We will discuss the people that follow Islam and what they are called.

*Discuss, at home, what you have learnt from the region Islam.*

## Art and Design

As Artists we will be learning how to draw different shapes and objects using different lines.

*You can help at home by drawing a picture and make sure you are using the 4 key points in shading.*

## Humanities

As Historians we will focus on our overarching question *The Stone Age*. During the lessons, we will look at the history of the Stone Age and what happened during that time period.
