

English

As readers and writers, we will be reading all about animals and then we will be creating our own animal fact files. We will be writing poetry all about ourselves and ,linked to our island role play, we will be reading and writing about Grandad's Island. **Read regularly with your child. Homework will be based around phonics. Encourage correct letter formation when writing.**

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be looking at place value with numbers up to 20 and then look at different techniques to add and subtract with numbers up to 20. **Recap on number bonds to 10 and then extend to numbers up to 20.**

Science

As scientists, we be looking at the various animal groups and their characteristics. These include: mammals, reptiles, birds, fish and amphibians. We will also be classifying them into carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. **What animals can you see in and around your garden?**

R.E

As theologians, we will continue looking at Christianity and cover the topic of incarnation.

Art and Design

As designer, we will be looking at where fruit and vegetables come from (this links to our geography unit). We will then be making, tasting and evaluating our own smoothies.

Look at fruit and vegetables at home. Do you know how and where they grow?

Humanities

As geographers, we will be looking at where our food comes from. This will include looking at dairy farms in Devon and banana production in Costa Rica.

Look at labels on food to find out where it comes from. Can you find it on a map?
