We will sharing many different books including Dear Zoo, Duck in a Truck, Elmer, The Three Little Pigs. The children will be thinking of words and sentences to describe the book characters.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be matching, sorting and comparing different groups.

We will start to look at measuring and spotting patterns.

Towards the end of the half term, we will look at the numbers 1,2 and 3.

Understanding of the world: Science

As scientists, we will be naming parts of our body and the use of our senses. We will go on senses walk around the school identifying what we can smell, hear, see and touch.

We will look at the season of Autumn and discuss how the leaves have changed on the trees and the colours of Autumn.

We will experiment with items that sink and float and predict which will sink and float.

Expressive Arts and Design

As artists, we will mark making using different media. We will use wax crayons, felt tips, chalk to make different marks on paper. Using an object, we will make observational drawings.

In DT, we will consider how a flange join is a stronger way of joining two things together.

Understanding of the world: Geography and History

As geographers, we will consider what Harvest means to us and how it is celebrated around the world.

When looking at the world map, we will learn that the sea is represented by blue and the land is represented by green.

In History, we will think about what the terms past and present mean and if the children can identify photographs from the past / present.

P.E

We will be practising changing ready for PE and changing back.

We will be moving in different ways. We will be using cones, balls and other equipment to show how we can move around the hall or move the equipment around using different body parts.

Music

As musicians, we will be listening to a new song each week, learning about it's origin and thinking whether we like the song and how it makes us feel. We will be learning nursery rhymes and songs with actions.
