# Home School Agreement

## As a parent of a child at Boxford Primary School I will:

- Keep the school informed of where to contact me in an emergency.

- Support the school in the teaching of safe and appropriate internet and on-line use at home.

- Attend school regularly and on time.
- Bring all the equipment I need every day.
- Be tidy in appearance and wear school uniform.
- Do all classwork and homework as well as I can; asking questions when needed.
- Be respectful towards others and behave in a safe and responsible way.
- Be kind, helpful and forgiving.
- Be honest, taking responsibility for actions and comments.
- Look after the school environment and respect other people's property.
- Use the internet and online devices safely as I have been taught in class.
- Tell a member of staff if I feel worried or unhappy.
